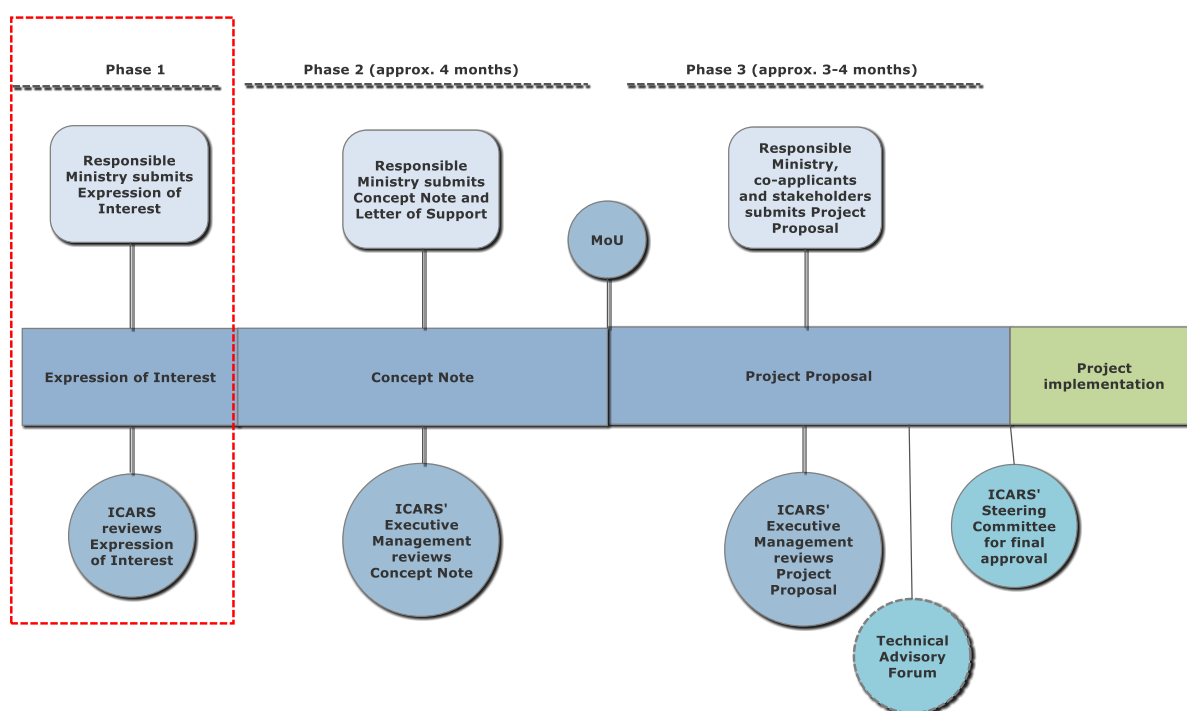

1. Introduction

The Expression of Interest (EoI) consists of a cover letter from the Responsible Ministry and a brief description of the proposed intervention or implementation demonstration project on the EoI Template (Appendix 1.1). The EoI should include a brief justification for the demonstration project in the context of the National Action Plan on AMR and a description of the intervention to be tested. The envisaged impact of the intervention on AMR should be stated together with a commitment to scale-up the intervention based on the proof of concept from the project. The Responsible Ministry should coordinate the development of the EoI.

2. Developing the EoI

The Responsible Ministry is requested to use the template provided in Appendix 1 when developing the EoI which should not exceed 2 A4 pages using Verdana font size 9 and 1.5 line spacing.

The EoI will be assessed by ICARS based on the following criteria (Table 2.):

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Is the envisaged impact on AMR well-articulated?
